1. AIR PRESSURE – THE FORCE APPLIED BECAUSE OF THE WEIGHT OF THE ATMOSPHERE.
2. AQUIFER – AN UNDERGROUND BODY OF ROCK WHERE WATER CAN SURFACE IN WELLS OR SPRINGS
3. CLIMATE – THE WEATHER CONDITIONS PREVAILING IN AN AREA OVER A LONG PERIOD OF TIME.
4. CONCENTRATION – THE AMOUNT OF A SUBSTANCE IN A MIXTURE IN A GIVEN AMOUNT OF SPACE
5. CORIOLIS EFFECT – THE PATTERN THAT WIND MOVES DUE TO THE ROTATION OF THE EARTH.
6. DENSITY – RATIO OF HOW MUCH MATTER (MASS) TO THE AMOUNT OF SPACE (VOLUME) IT TAKES UP.
7. HUMIDITY – HOW MUCH WATER IS IN THE ATMOSPHERE
8. HYDROLOGIC – SCIENCE CONCERNED WITH THE PROPERTIES OF THE EARTH'S WATER, AND ESPECIALLY ITS MOVEMENT IN RELATION TO LAND
9. JUSTIFY – SHOW OR PROVE TO BE RIGHT OR REASONABLE.
10. PATTERN – AN ARRANGEMENT OR DESIGN REGULARLY FOUND IN COMPARABLE OBJECTS.
11. PREDICT – TO MAKE A GUESS BASED ON OBSERVATIONS, EXPERIENCE, OR REASONING.
12. RUNOFF – THE DRAINING OF WATER FROM THE SURFACE OF AN AREA OF LAND
13. SALINITY – THE AMOUNT OF SALT IN SOMETHING.
14. TRANSPIRATION – THE EVAPORATION OF WATER FROM PLANTS INTO THE ATMOSPHERE
15. VOLUME – THE AMOUNT OF SPACE AN OBJECT TAKES UP
